**SI PUO FARE** Italy / 2008 / 110 minutes

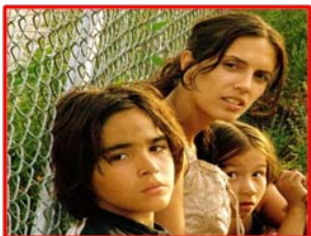
Nello loses his job and ends up managing a group of ex-mental patients. When they are denied psychiatric help, he invents new occupational roles for each of them. This film walks a fine line between farce and compassion, and comedy and drama.

Babou shrugs off everything – jobs, husbands, responsibilities. When her daughter is too ashamed of her to invite her to her wedding, Babou has to change. Can she find a job and a fitting wedding gift, but still remain true to herself?

**ENTRE NOS** USA & Columbia / 2009 / 82 minutes

Mariana's children have grown up in Columbia without their father. After years of separation, the family is reunited in NY. Then Antonio announces he has found work in Miami and will send for them. **THE WHITE COUNTESS** United Kingdom/ 2005 / 135 minutes

Russian Countess Sophia and her family find refuge in Shanghai in 1936. She supports the family by working as a bar girl and taxi dancer, but forms an alliance with a former diplomat, owner of an elegant bar. Their relationship blossoms until they are caught in the fall of the city to the Japanese invasion.
